

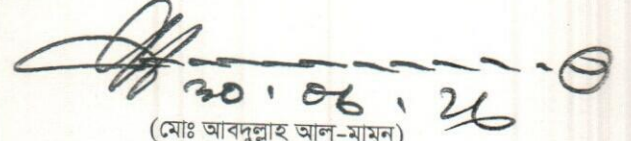

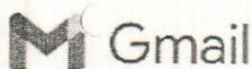

Note:

This training is delivered as **synchronous** digital learning and teaching. Potential participants should be aware that daily sessions start at **09:00 CET**. Based on experience, participation from time zones more than **±1 hour from CET** can be difficult to manage. The course is designed as a full-time, camera-on program. Active participation throughout the day is required. Parallel professional duties or other commitments during training hours are therefore not compatible with the course format.

For Member States or institutes located in other time zones, the deployment of a mobile training team may be considered as an alternative. A key precondition is the availability of a stable, high-speed internet connection, as well as dedicated office space for exclusive use throughout the duration of the training.

Course Description

In the field of education and training, few topics have generated as much discussion in recent years as the digitalisation of teaching and learning. With the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, training providers worldwide were confronted with the immediate challenge of either cancelling courses or transferring them into virtual formats—often without prior experience or established methodologies for doing so effectively.

Key questions quickly emerged: How can active, participatory and adult-oriented teaching be transferred into a virtual environment? How can group work be organised online? Which tools support interaction and collaboration? And how can trainers maintain participants' attention in synchronous digital settings? This period resulted in numerous learning moments—both challenging and enlightening—and highlighted the need for structured, practice-oriented approaches to digital teaching.

The *Train the eTrainer* programme directly addresses these challenges. It offers participants the opportunity to reflect on practical experiences, broaden their pedagogical skillset, and develop the competencies required for effective synchronous digital teaching. Drawing on several years of hands-on experience, the programme focuses not only on lessons learned from unsuccessful approaches, but also on methods and practices that have demonstrated significant potential.

A key feature of the programme is its pragmatic and inclusive approach. It does not rely on complex technologies or costly licensed tools. Instead, it builds on tools that are widely available, such as modern video-conferencing systems, and demonstrates how meaningful learning experiences can be created through targeted methodological adjustments. This ensures that the programme is accessible and applicable across diverse organisational and technical contexts.

The aim of the course is to empower trainers and subject matter experts with the principles, and methods necessary to design and facilitate effective synchronous digital learning environments.

Key learning objectives include the ability to:

- Explain the differences between communication in online learning environments and face-to-face courses
- Describe challenges related to concentration and attention in synchronous online settings and identify strategies to address them
- Identify tools that support participatory teaching in online learning environments
- Outline the pedagogical potential of modern video-conferencing systems for digital teaching
- Describe and apply cooperative learning methods in online environments
- Develop and demonstrate a cooperative online teaching sequence using newly acquired methods and tools within the participants' own professional context

The course is designed for trainers and subject matter experts involved in learning-related activities such as trainings, workshops and seminars at national and international levels. While prior knowledge of methodology and didactics is beneficial, it is not mandatory, as all relevant concepts are addressed in a highly practical and accessible manner throughout the course.
